

San Francisco Township - Carver County - MN

Monthly Board Meeting
November 17, 2014

Meeting called to order at 7:05PM by chairman Maidie Felton. Those present were board members: Maidie Felton, Larry Schmidt and Kevin Lundquist Treasurer: Denise Anderson and Clerk Heidi Schmidt and 3 residents.

Minutes from the October meeting were reviewed and approved.

Treasurers report as follows: \$89,160.14 in checking and \$181,761.22 in savings

ROAD REPORT:

- Roads may be rough. They didn't get much grading done before the freeze.
- Larry will call Faxon township to see how they plan to proceed with the snowplowing on Market Ave.
- The rock at 182nd St needs to be cleaned up before it is covered with snow.
- The addresses on 187th St are not in order. Heidi will check on this at P&Z.
- Rademacher/Market Ave wants the ditch cleaned out. Dave has been notified

BRIDGE REPLACEMENT: Bids will be opened Dec 11th for culverts.

Easement has been signed by Johnson and agreed to by Mellgren's. They need to be recorded.

Inspection shows the East Bridge on 166th St is severely scoured out below the aprons. The West bridge shows stress cracks on the East side and the road will probably break away with spring rain and melt.

FEMA only wants to pay to fix the bridge (not replace it) The county says it can not be fixed. Darin will get a new bid for the repair and FEMA may pay that much toward the replacement.

PLANNING AND ZONING:

Hearing tomorrow evening about the 2030 comprehensive plan that has a trail running along county Road 40. Plan says it will be mapped to decrease value and then it can be acquired cheaply. The map shows 500' from the road center to be used for the trail. This will definitely affect several of our residents living along that road. Larry and Maidie will attend.

ORDINANCE 8:

Public hearing will be held at the Church by the River in Carver to discuss the requested changes to the ordinance by Terry Hanson and Chard Tiling. The board reviewed the hearing procedures provided by the Association of Townships. Troy Gilchrist will be present to help implement procedures and answer legal questions.
