The monthly meeting of the San Francisco Township Board was held on July 20th at 7PM.

Board members convened at 6:45 to review accounts payable and authorize payments.

The business meeting was called to order at 7PM by Chairman Doug Weber. Those present were Board members: Larry Schmidt, Kevin Lundquist and Doug Weber, Clerk: Heidi Schmidt, Treasurer: Denise Anderson and approximately 6 residents.

The minutes from the June meeting were read online and approved as submitted.

Treasurer reported \$238,887.64 in checking and \$181,883.05 in CDs. Check signers have visited the bank and are officially recorded on the account. Denise has tried to put more financial info on the web but it is in the wrong format. Report accepted.

Joe Forrest from Rehben's Ag Services was present to explain the product that some farmer's have contracted to use on their fields. The product is ash from the Dakota Energy Plant and lime from the St Paul water treatment plant. It has been approved through the county and the EPA.

There was a discussion on the reclamation project at the Hanson Pit. The three supervisors have visited the pit. Chard would like to use the top soil at the site, start within the set back and create a gentle sloping hill. They would create less noise and it would be quicker. The adjoining homeowner objects to the plan as it would remove the berm barrier that now separates his home from the mine. There are items in the ordinance that do not allow this type of procedure, primarily because it is being done within the set back. The ordinance must be followed or amended.

There board decided they need to see a site plan and probably revisit the site to see the boundaries before making any decision.

ROAD AND BRIDGE:

- Bridge - plans are complete. Larry will follow up with Troy about easements for property owners.
- Ditches have been mowed.
- There is a tree down on Joyce Rd. Olson constr will be asked to remove it.
- Larry will talk to Dave about Market Ave
- Halsey Road right of way was discussed. This year there are beans planted, but if it goes back to corn the ditch will have to be reclaimed.
- There are some culvert signs that need to be put up.
