

San Francisco Township Monthly Meeting – November 21st, 2016

The monthly meeting of the San Francisco Township Board was held on November 21st. Board members convened at 6:45 to review accounts payable and authorize payments.

Vice Chairman Larry Schmidt called the business meeting to order at 7:00. Present were Board members, Larry Schmidt, Kevin Lundquist, Treasurer Denise Andersen, Clerk Heidi Schmidt and 7 residents.

The October minutes were reviewed. Approved. They will be posted on the website. Treasurer reported \$78,807.30 in checking and \$268,141.23 in CDs. Report was accepted.

Planning and Zoning

Roger Walsh has requested a permit on 154th St. He needs a variance for building a home with only a 5' setback from the property line to stay the correct distance from the ravine and save the existing trees. He will apply for driveway permit after he get building permit finalized. Motion passed to approve variance app. Hearing will be Dec 7th. Larry can sign county paper at that time.

Mining:

Doug recently visited pit with LeRoy Chard. He is checking on acreage guidelines. Neighbor says it has been relatively quiet recently.

Road and Bridge Report:

- Doug says county will not pursue sign bill since the money was not collected by the township from FEMA.
- Reviewed road maintenance list. Remove Langley Rd project as that is in the far future. Koepf Dr and Halsey should be looked at for 2017 projects.
- Rapid Lakes Rd application was reviewed by Larry and Kevin, explained to residents in attendance and Larry made a motion to submit the application. Kevin will follow up.

Old Business:
