

San Francisco Township Monthly Meeting
May 20, 2019

The monthly meeting of the San Francisco Township Board was held on May 20th. Board members convened at 6:45 to review accounts payable and authorize payments.

Vice-Chairman Larry Schmidt called the business meeting to order at 7:00. Present were Board members, Larry Schmidt and Kevin Lundquist, Treasurer Denise Andersen, Clerk Heidi Schmidt and 7 residents. All present stood and recited the pledge of allegiance.

The April 2019 minutes were reviewed. Approved. They will be posted on the website. Treasurer reported \$137,743. in checking and \$483,485 in CDs. Report was accepted.

ROAD AND BRIDGE The solar plant on Market has applied for driveway permit. There is discussion if this goes to Hancock township as it is their section of the road. Discussion about the road agreement concluded with the fact that the two boards need to meet and discuss the arrangement. Kevin will coordinate the dustcoating with Northern Salt. It is set for May 30th – weather permitting.

MINING A check will be issued to OMG for \$42.23 to close out the escrow account.

CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE The application has been sent in for a grant to hire a firm to determine if the town hall meets the specifications to be considered historical. They may hear in June. The Spring Newsletter has been sent.

Larry has obtained a flyer on Wild Parsnip and it's danger.

OLD BUSINESS Animal Ordinance is tabled until June. No new information.

ROW Ordinance is being worked on by Doug so no information at this time.

2040 Comp Plan is meeting with the commissioner 5/21. A motion was made to approve the additional language added to the San Francisco Township section of the plan. Second. Passed.

NEW BUSINESS There have been questions for citizens about the gas plant expansion on County Rd 40. This is in Dahlgren Township and is a public utility project through Carver County. Larry has worked on such projects and they are highly regulated by the Federal Government.

There was an application for a temporary liquor license for a fund raiser for the Justin Kukowski Foundation. It is a wine tasting event to be held at the Solseng Farm – 16315 Jonathon Carver Pkwy. Motion made to approve. Second. Passed.
