Board members convened at 6:45 to review accounts payable and authorize payments.

Board meeting called to order at 7:00. Present were Board members, Doug Weber and Kevin Lundquist, Treasurer Denise Andersen, Clerk Heidi Schmidt and 5 residents. All present stood and recited the pledge of allegiance.

The November 2019 minutes were reviewed. Approved. They will be posted on the website. Treasurer reported checking balance of \$73,539. CDs worth \$385,224. Fun note, received a \$6.11 dividend from MidCounty Co-op from 1984. Report was accepted.

Planning & Zoning: Vote on the Lundquist gravel pit, (in Dahlgren) has been postponed until 12/17.

Road and Bridge Report: There is a grant available to fight the wild parsnips. Doug is following up on application. Culvert at Halsey & 50 has been blocked by homeowner. Ron Olson was present to talk about plowing. He has been putting chip rock down on slippery spots. We must remind residents Not to plow snow across the road.

Mining: No update

Citizens Committee: The consultant hired is working on a story about our building to present to the historical society when we apply for Historical Status. He has discovered that the original school burned in 1916 when Ms Forrell was the teacher. This building was built to State Plan 3 specs in 1917 at a cost of \$4500. District 22 was open until 1946. Committee has suggested a public forum when the story is complete for residents that want to learn the township history.

Old Business: Doug will continue working on getting high speed internet through Jaquar

New Business: Next newsletter should go out in January to talk about plowing and elections.

Notes from the clerk: Heidi will put snowplowing information on the website. Carver County Hazard Mitigation Plan has been approved.
