San Francisco Twp. Annual Meeting—County Updates

Highway 212 Dahlgren Phase (Carver to Cologne, 4.5 miles)

- Fully funded: \$50 million
 - \$22 million in Federal grants
 - \$19 million in State funds
 - \$9 million from County sales-tax fund
- Timeline
 - March-April 2021: Tree clearing
 - May 2021: Main grading work
 - November 2022: Projected completion
- Project done in stages—no detours (except short term for special situations)

Other Upcoming Road Construction Projects

- Jonathan Carver Parkway Project: Includes reconstruction and expansion from just south of 4th Street to Highway 61. Construction work starts towards the end March depending on weather conditions. A full closure of the highway will occur from mid-June through August, with Highways 50/43 and 212 the detour route. Construction should be complete by the end of fall.
- Highway 50 Project (Bevens Creek area): Shoulder widening and pavement rehabilitation from Highway 41 to Highway 40 from mid-summer through early fall.
- Resurfacing Projects: All of Highway 140, Highway 44 from 43 to 11, and Highway 43 from Highway 50 to Maplewood Road.
- Bridge Replacement Projects: Dual line box culverts over Carver Creek on Highway 140

CARES Act Funding (Received from State)—Township Breakdown

- San Francisco Township: \$21,700

COVID-19 Update

- Lead seven-county metro in vaccination rates among residents 65+ (64% as of March 1)
- Currently vaccinating: Residents 65+, pre-k-12th grade staff, and child care workers
- Partnership with Ridgeview allows County Public Health to provide doses to western partners, such as Lakeview Clinics and Watertown Pharmacy
- Public Health has solid plans to deliver COVID-19 vaccine on a larger scale once supplies increase
