RESOLUTION TO PROCEED WITH ROAD RECORDING PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Town Board is the road authority over the town roads within San Francisco Township ("Town");

WHEREAS, providing for the on-going maintenance and, as needed, improvement of the Town's roads is a significant part of the services the Town provides to its residents;

WHEREAS, having well-defined rights-of-way is important to ensure the Town is able to provide safe and well-maintained roads for Town residents and the traveling public;

WHEREAS, the Town's attorney has advised the Town Board that the best method for ensuring the Town has recorded rights-of-way the Town Board can rely on is to undertake the process in Minnesota Statutes, section 164.07 to establish the Town's existing roads with a uniform width;

WHEREAS, the Town Board needs the Town electors to exercise their authority under Minnesota Statutes, section 164.06, subdivision 1 to authorize the Town Board to utilize the Minnesota Statutes, section 164.07 procedure as needed to establish and record the Town's roads with a uniform width;


WHEREAS, the Town Board determines it is in the best interests of the Town to seek elector authorization to undertake the project to record the Town's roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board as follows:


1. The Town Board will call a special town meeting in order to seek authorization from the electors to undertake the project to record the Town's roads with a uniform width.
2. If the electors provide the requested authorization, the Town Board will undertake the road recording project, which the Town Board understands will take time as it requires the Town Board to work through the statutory process and communicate with the owners along the roads.
