

# San Francisco Township Hall Renovation Project



Our Historic Town Hall is in need of repairs to keep it from deteriorating further, bring it up to code for public meetings, and preserve its historical presence in our township, as well as a community gathering place.

The Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC) has been looking into this project. Some of the needs are as follows:

## 1. Safety and Structure Stabilization

1. Foundation repair
2. Provide required second egress door
3. Update electrical
4. Seal to keep moisture out
5. Tuck pointing

## 2. Code Compliance for Community Building

1. Add restrooms
2. Provide water and sewage
3. Open up and restore windows
4. Programable heat

## 3. Interior Improvements

1. Patch and paint walls & ceilings
2. Refinish floors
3. Upgrade lighting
4. Provide for audio visual equipment & internet access

## 4. Exterior/ Site Improvement

1. Landscape, signage, picnic area, etc.

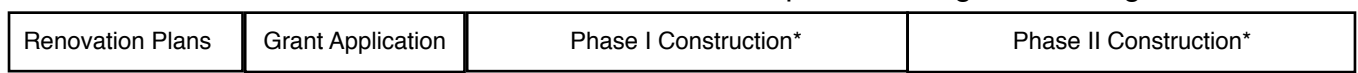
**These would be done in phases with one and two being the most important.**

In order to keep cost down the CAC has applied to put the building on the National Historical Register thus opening the door for grants to preserve the building.

Our Town Hall is the ONLY public building in the township and is used for voting and public meetings. Restoring the building would open it up for other community uses such as classes, group meeting, township gatherings (annual picnic anyone?)
