PRIMARY ELECTIONS AUGUST 9, 2022

SAN FRANCISCO TOWN HALL (17380 Homestead Rd) 7:00 A.M.- 8:00 P.M.

Primary Elections are used by political parties to select candidates for the General Election in November. Then each party's candidates run against each other in the General Election November. During a Primary Election voters are required to vote between the candidates of their preferred party. Crossing party lines will cause a ballot to be rejected and the voter will be offered a new ballot. The rejected ballot is nullified and not counted.

SAN FRANCISCO TOWNSHIP FILING NOTICE

The annual San Francisco Township General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. Two Supervisor positions and the treasurer position are open for 2023-2026. The Supervisory positions up for elections are Supervisor A: Scott Selken (Kevin Lundquist's term) and Supervisor B: Andy Olson (Doug Weber's term). The treasurer position is currently held by Denise Andersen.

Filing for candidates will open August 2nd, 2022 at 8:00 am and close August 16th, 2022 at 5:00 pm. (Forms for filing can be found on the San Francisco Township website.) The "Affidavits of Candidacy" form should be mailed to: Attn: Jeanne Aufderheide, Dept. Clerk San Francisco Township, 6325 Cove Road, Carver, MN 55315.

Forms can also be submitted at the Township Meeting held on the August 15th at 7 pm, Township Hall on Homestead RD, Carver. Filing fee is \$2.00.

On August 16th, the last day of filing, the deputy clerk's office will be open from 1-5 pm at 6325 Cove Road, home of Jeanne Aufderheide. Don't forget your \$2 filing fee!

Board Agenda Deadline Reminder

The deadline for being on the meeting agenda will be by noon (12 pm) on Monday, a week prior to the regularly scheduled board meeting (3rd Monday of the month). This deadline will usually be the **SECOND MONDAY** of the month.

- The site for District School 22 was purchased in 1898.
- Current school building was built in 1917 after the old wooden school was destroyed by fire.
- The school was closed in 1947 when school districts were consolidated.
- The Township has been using the building as the Township Hall since 1950 - 72 years!
- About 865 monthly meeting have been held in the building. How many special meetings???
- There are no other public buildings in the township.

TOWNSHIP HALL UPDATE

We are 60-70% complete. The chimney was rebuilt. The foundation was repaired and stabilized (NE corner was failing and is now fixed). Tuck pointing is nearly complete. Windows are done and will be installed in the next few weeks along with painting, roof repairs, gutters, and stabilizing of the porch. Representatives from the MN Historical Society have visited the site and were pleased with the progress and community involvement. Volunteers from our township are backfilling basement with sand to reinforce the foundation. The sand and delivery is donated by Chard Excavating. A special thanks to our volunteers and Chard for their help. More volunteer opportunities will be available in the future. Consider helping make our Town Hall a building we can be proud of.
