

Public Hearing on May 18th is only to review proposed changes to the mining ordinance and to explain how the Ordinance, IUP (Interim Use Permit) and Operations Plan work together.

At approximately 6:45 p.m., using any new information about COVID-19 guidelines, the Board will pick a new date for the continuation of this hearing which will then include the public comment portion of the hearing.

## **CAC member, Lou Longhenry, Finds Missing Township Records in Basement of Carver Country Historical Society Building.**

These Township records date from 1858-1968. There are almost 2500 pages of hand-written notes, meetings document, and reports for 110 years in five leather bound books.

The first several years of the early township board meetings were held in various homes of town board members. The first annual meeting at School District 22 was April 6, 1869 (and have been held there ever since). More township information to come!
