ALERT! MAILBOX THEFTS

THERE HAVE BEEN REPORTS OF MAIL STOLEN FROM MAILBOXES ALONG TOWNSHIP ROADS. The information is suspected to be used in identity theft. Please pick up mail in a timely manner and consider bringing anything with money or credit information directly to the post office.

WILD PARSNIPS

When identified in the right of way, the township will spray that right of way. Please notify them if you see any in the township right of way. Parsnips is known to be harmful and deadly in some cases to livestock. Care should be taken when working on any equipment that is used to mow as the parsnip oil can be on the equipment and spread to humans that come in contact. If parsnips is found on private property it should be eradicated and if you would like information on how to proceed please contact the township board.

WHERE OR WHERE TO PUT THE SNOW

Snow will be coming soon....and where to pile that snow when clearing your driveway? DO NOT PLOW IT ACROSS A TOWNSHIP ROAD INTO THE DITCH. RIDGES CAN CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE SNOWPLOW AND CAUSE OTHER PROBLEMS.

Minnesota Statute 160.2715 prohibits the plowing, blowing, shoveling or otherwise placing of snow from sidewalks, driveways and parking lots onto or across public roads into the right-of-way (in general 33 feet from the center of the road).

Snow dumped, plowed or shoveled onto a road or road right-of-way can create a hazard for both motorists and snowplows. Snowplows have been damaged by hitting compacted snow. **Please ensure that snow from your property or equipment is not pushed or dumped onto the right-of-way.**

Please find a spot on your property to pile the snow and keep it off the Township roads and out of the township ditches. Snow that is piled in the right away will be removed and the property owner will be charged by the township. Thanks for keeping our roads safe.
