Resolution No. 21-02**

**RESOLUTION DETERMINING ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT
WORKSHEET INFORMATION IS COMPLETE AND AUTHORIZING NEXT STEPS**

WHEREAS, San Francisco Township (“Town”) was notified that Ron Olson (“Proposer”) is proposing to apply for an interim use permit from the Town for a new sand and gravel mining operation within the Town;

WHEREAS, the Town requires the preparation of an environmental assessment worksheet (“EAW”) for new mining operations;

WHEREAS, the Town is the responsible government unit (“RGU”) for this project and it hired Wenck (“Consultant”) to assist the Town to complete the EAW process; and

WHEREAS, the Proposer’s engineering firm submitted the data for the EAW and the Town is required under Minnesota Rules, part 4410.1400 to determine if the data is complete.


NOW, THEREFORE, based on the information and advice of the Consultant, the Town Board of San Francisco Township resolves as follows:


1. The Town Board determines the Proposer’s submittal regarding the EAW is complete for the purposes of the determination required under Minnesota Rules, part 4410.1400.
2. The Town Board authorizes the EAW for distribution once the Consultant obtains any supplementary material it determines is needed and the EAW is deemed final.
3. The Consultant is hereby authorized and directed to do the following:
 - a. Notify the Proposer of this determination within five days of the date of this Resolution;
 - b. Determine if any supplementary material is needed and to notify the Proposal of the additional material requirements within 30 days of the date of this Resolution;
 - c. Once the EAW is finalized, take such steps as are needed to distribute and publish notice of the EAW in accordance with the applicable laws;
 - d. Prepare responses to the comments received;
 - e. Present the comments and responses to the Town Board along with proposed findings of fact and recommendation on whether an environmental impact statement should be required; and

- f. Take such other steps as may be needed to assist the Town to complete the EAW process in accordance with applicable laws.
